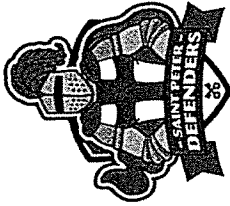

- Significant policy and process that all must follow
- APF003- form to submit to Terry Pickett detail all info on changes to make to facility
- Terry Pickett will assign to her team to review may come to site and will approve or deny (also include timeline)
- Currently a busy time right now for them
- Procurement Perspective- purchasing threshold anything up to 9,999 budget holder (principal make purchase order and pick from a provided list of vendors- not competitive process that needs to be followed)
- After 10,000 Admins team is involved and must get 3 quotes.
- Asphalt repair- is facilities check to see when we are coming up for that to be done
- Decor line painting could be more expensive
- Typically yellow is a stand out colour
- Board policy you can not split purchases to defeat the policy
- Capital repairs email Terry and check when your up and next
- 50% of cost is going to come from installation
 - To help people adjust that you may not feel your getting full cost of what you are paying for

- Between 10-100,000 we can ask for three quotes after 100,000 open game
- Provincial approval now for anything over 25,000
- Admins and team will submit report to province more to showcase what we are doing and where our money is going.
- For bigger projects we wanted to get parent and student input on choice
- Stuart Hoise maintenance supervisor- if someone is coming to do lines in parking lot he can come and do other lines

- Lots of liability over who does work for us that we must meet from legislative requirement.

- If you are looking at doing fundraising- apply for as many grants as possible
